

UPDATE: Door County will be cancelling remaining Wisconsin National Guard COVID 19 Testing Clinics that were planned through early March. The dates that will be affected are: February 22nd, March 1st, and March 8th. The main reason for the cancellation is primarily due to the drop in demand for the service.

Door County had been partnering with the Wisconsin National Guard to provide this service since October of 2020 on a weekly recurring basis in both Sister Bay and Sturgeon Bay. Testing numbers have slowly declined since the start of the new year. This trend is consistent across all areas within Wisconsin and not just Door County.

Testing will still be available in Door County through Door County Medical Center, Monday through Friday from 8:00AM – 4:30PM.

Door County Emergency Management along with Door County Public Health and its partners will continue to monitor the demand for testing in the County both now and into the future. If the demand reaches a point where additional resources are deemed to be needed, requests to resume testing will be made.
